She is a student/ She is at school (1° Ella es un estudiante, 2° Ella está en la escuela)

It is a dog/ It is in the park (1° Esto es un perro, 2° Esto esta en el parque)

We are students/ We are at school (1º Nosotros somos estudiantes, 2º Nosotros estamos en la escuela)

They are students/ They are at school (1º Ello/a/es son estudiantes, 2º Ello/a/es están en la escuela)
